After spending two days and nights exploring the Bavarian City of Three Rivers, Passau, step aboard the deluxe class MV Fortuna with 170 passenger capacity. This is a much more luxurious boat than we have experienced in the past and we will be sharing with others beyond our Pensacola group. All cabins are equipped with private bath w/ shower, TV, safe and air conditioning. The MV Fortuna has a panorama restaurant, salon w/bar, library, sundeck, partly covered, Wifi (surcharge) and services laundry available. Beverages/Alcohol are available for purchase and are paid by EUROS or Credit card at the end of the week. The water on the boat is drinkable. For this cruise you can choose to bike daily or choose to participate in the excursions offered daily on the boat.

Our cycling group will Cycle the Danube Bike Path along one of Europe's most famous rivers with a guide. Between the Austrian and Hungarian landscape and the Danube River Bend, natural beauty awaits as well as art, culture and history. The biking is rated as easy, with a few rolling hills, as we cycle 22-35 miles daily. This mileage is stop and go, visit and look, drink and eat kind of riding.
