



# 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Denver March Powwow Rules for Drum Groups

## \$100 Cash Registration Fee

Lead Singer will be asked for I.D. (Drivers License,  
Tribal ID, etc.)

All Drums Welcome ★ No Limit on Drums

Public Address System will be Provided

Upon arrival Friday or Saturday, only Lead Singer should enter to register and pick up Drum Packet.

1. All lead singers must register (\$100 cash registration fee) their drum group to be eligible for drum monies. Drum Registration on site will open after Ground Blessing Thursday, March 19 and will close at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, March 20, 2025.
2. Drum groups must set up at the location assigned to them by the Drum Coordinator and set up in the same location each session.
3. To answer drum roll call and qualify for payment, at least 2 singers and the drum must be present. All registered drums are eligible for day money. Drum registration will close 30 minutes before each grand entry and open when grand entry is over.
4. Song lengths will be limited as follows: Intertribals - 6 pushups: Contests - 4 pushups: and Grand Entry - 4 pushups.
5. Drum rotation will be clockwise for intertribals and counter-clockwise for contest songs. EXCEPTION: Northern drums for northern contest categories and Southern drums for southern contest categories.
6. Drum groups may not sell their CDs, DVDs, tee shirts or any other merchandise.
7. Any singers suspected of alcohol/drug use, exhibiting inappropriate behavior, or not complying with the above by the Arena Director or Committee will cause the drum group to be disqualified for that session and will not receive payment.
8. By registering, you are giving the Denver March Powwow, Inc., permission to use your photo/image/songs as part of their public relations material.
