SEED & TRANSPLANT DISTRIBUTIONS

Gardeners are responsible for picking up their seeds and transplants. Distributions occur at the KGSB Garden, located at **575 W Base Line, San Bernardino, CA** 92410 with alternate options for those with health or mobility challenges. **You will receive information one month prior with exact dates and times for each distribution.**

Cold Weather Seeds & Transplants: Begin 3rd week of April Hot Weather Seeds & Transplants: Begin 3rd week of May Fall Weather Seeds & Transplants: Begin 3rd week of July

Garlic: In mid-October
