



Disaster CalFresh Benefits

If you live or work in San Bernardino County and had expenses or lost money due to the severe winter storms that occurred from Feb. 21 through March 22, you may be eligible to receive Disaster CalFresh benefits.

Disaster CalFresh provides a month's worth of benefits on an Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card that can be used to purchase food at authorized locations.

If you already receive CalFresh food benefits, you are not eligible for Disaster CalFresh.

Excluded CalFresh household members not receiving benefits for any of the following reasons, may be eligible for Disaster CalFresh:

- Ineligible noncitizen
- Ineligible student
- Receiving Indian Food Commodities, or
- Disqualified for any of the following reasons:
 - ✓ Not providing a Social Security Number (SSN)
 - ✓ Not complying with work requirements
 - ✓ Intentional Program Violation (IPV)
