


WHEN A COACH (OR NON-PLAYER) IS IN THE RESTRICTED AREA DURING A LIVE BALL



Sideline Interference (Rule 9-8-3)


If a player, coach, or non-player is in the restricted area while the ball is live but does not contact an official, a warning is issued for the first offense. The second instance results in a 5yd penalty and the third offense results in a 15yd penalty. It's important to remember that a second Unsportsmanlike Conduct penalty on the head coach for any reason will result in disqualification.

REFEREE SIGNAL SEQUENCE:


First Offense (Warning):




Second Offense (5yds):




Third Offense (15yds):

WHEN A COACH (OR NON-PLAYER) IS IN THE RESTRICTED AREA DURING A LIVE BALL




Unintentional Contact in Restricted Area (Rule 9-4-8)

Personal Foul - Non-player Contacting an Official

If an official and a coach (or non-player) collides in the restricted area during a live ball the offending team is penalized 15 yards for Illegal Personal Contact.
