INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE TEMPORARY BEAR SEALING FORM

If you can't get your bear to a sealing officer in person, you must complete and sign a Temporary Bear Sealing Form, available at any ADF&G office. You must also make sure someone takes the bear and temporary sealing form to a sealing officer within 30 days of kill.

- If you are a nonresident and kill a bear while on a guided hunt or while hunting with an Alaska-licensed resident relative with second-degree of kindred, both you and your guide or resident relative must sign the sealing certificate or temporary sealing form.
- This form cannot be duplicated. Contact ADF&G each time this form is needed to make sure you have the most recent version.
- Sealing is required for:
 - All brown/grizzly bears, except those taken under a subsistence permit in (and not removed from) a brown bear subsistence area.
 - Black bears taken in GMUs 1-7, 14A, 14C, 15-17, 20B: Hide and skull during Jan 1-May 31; skull during June 1-Dec 31. All black bear hides and skulls removed from Alaska or offered for sale.
- The skull must be removed from the hide for sealing. Skull and hide must be unfrozen.
- Print clearly. ALL fields are required prior to sealing unless indicated by as ADF&G USE ONLY (shaded gray box with thick border). See information below for an explanation of fields:

HUNTER INFORMATION — Complete all boxes. If resident hunter is younger than 18, enter the hunter's age in place of the hunting license. Example: AGE00015.

HUNT/CONTROL NUMBER — Enter the numbers from the hunting permit, harvest ticket, or control permit. Examples: all black bear general harvest ticket hunts **GL000**, grizzly predation control permit MB301. Leave blank if no harvest ticket or permit required.

PERMIT/TICKET NUMBER — Example: 1234567-89. Leave blank if no harvest ticket or permit required.

PREDATOR CONTROL AND HUNT box — Check **Predator Control** only if the bear was taken under a predation control permit. Select the **hunt type** and **hunt manager** for bears taken by hunters. Leave blank if bear was killed in non-hunting way such as Defense of Life or Property (DLP).

BIG GAME LOCKING-TAG NUMBER — Enter the big game tag number the hunter locked to the hide upon harvesting the animal. Leave blank if big game tag is not required.

BEAR BAIT STATION SITE # — If taken over bait enter the bait station site number. Brown/grizzly bears can be taken over bait only under specific permits.

DAYS HUNTED — Enter the total number of days or parts of days spent in the field with the intent to harvest a bear.

GMU/SUBUNIT — Enter 3 digit alpha-numeric code for the GMU where the animal was taken. Example: 01D, 23Z, 26A.

DATE OF KILL — Enter date of kill (mm-dd-yy)

MOUNTAIN RANGE & DRAINAGE — Record the mountain range and/or drainage where bear was killed.

SPECIFIC LOCATION — List one or more: distance from a landmark, location on a river, milepost on a highway, island name. GPS coordinates may also be added.

OTHER INFORMATION AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES USED — Check all that apply.

TRANSPORTATION USED — Record the last method used to get to where you started walking to hunt.

NON-HUNTING KILL INFO — Leave blank for hunter-killed bears. Bears killed legally during hunting season in defense of life or property (DLP) are considered hunter-killed if the hunter keeps the bear (no DLP form needed). **Predator Control**: bears killed under predation control permit.

METHOD OF TAKE — Record the method used. If "other", specify.

COMMENTS (MARKED BEARS) — Note details (#, color, etc.) for any tattoo, ear tag, radio collar, or other pertinent features. If a skull is missing a premolar and/or an ear has a hole or split, the bear was likely marked so you must note this.

SIGNATURES: HUNTER, GUIDE AND SEALER INFORMATION — Hunter signature is required on sealing certificate or attached temporary sealing certificate. Guide signature and info is required for guided bear hunters. Complete all guide information.

- ☐ Give this completed Temporary Bear Sealing Form along with the unfrozen hide and skull (removed from the hide) to the person bringing your bear to a sealing officer to get sealed.
- ☐ Fill out a Transfer of Possession Form (back page of Alaska Hunting Regulations). Keep a copy and give a copy to the person bringing your bear to a sealing officer to get sealed.
