Luke and Amy Nelson are with Mission Aviation Fellowship, an aviation ministry that has been serving isolated people for over 75 years. They are preparing to serve in the southern African nation of Lesotho. Luke will serve as a pilot/mechanic; reaching out to isolated communities living in Lesotho's rugged highlands to provide medical care and access to the gospel. Amy will be home with their two children and hopes to share her faith with their neighbors through relationship building. They need an additional \$300/month in order to be fully funded before moving overseas. After graduation from Prairie Bible Institute, Whitworth University and Wycliffe Bible Translator's Summer Institute of Linguistics program, she worked almost 18 years among the Kimyal people in Irian Jaya (now called Papua), Indonesia. Today she lives in Chattaroy, Washington. She mentors future and current missionaries, edits the Great Commission Kids publication, blogs, and speaks on behalf of spreading the knowledge of God around the world.
