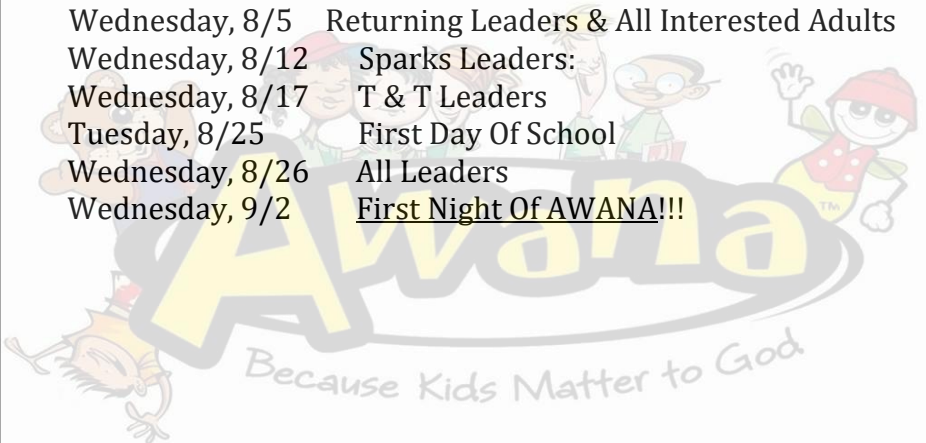

Central Asia



Leif and Jami Gustafson are living and working in Central Asia with their children Anneka, Ella, and Ike. They are on work visas as teachers at an international school and are building relationships in neighboring countries as well as with local brothers and sisters, plus providing leadership to their organization's team in the area.

They are active in helping lead small groups to share God's word with unbelievers and the new church they helped to plant is growing with new believers particularly among young people.

Their prayer is to see a movement of disciple makers among the unreached people groups of Central Asia as well as the Buryats of Siberia, among whom they lived and worked for 16 years.

This fall, pray especially that as Anneka begins to study biology at the University of Washington that she will find a church and campus ministry to give her support and ways to serve.
