#### Oleg and Marina Reutki with New Hope Eurasia

Oleg and Marina Reutki are with New Hope Eurasia. They reside in Moldova and have a passion to reach their country and the surrounding ones with the love of Jesus. Ever since the fall of the USSR, the doors have been open to transform the lives of those who lived without hope under that regime. Their focus is on the children of the next generation and they are involved in numerous ministries, including visiting orphanages (along with their own four children whom they include in ministry), teaching in the public schools on health/social issues while sharing the gospel; partnering with local churches and training workers; conducting teen youth meetings and camps; and running transition homes for girls who have timed out of foster care.

Since February 2022 they have been helping refugees who cross from Ukraine into Moldova. Then a major earthquake hit Turkey in February 2023 and they have been involved there in relief efforts as well.
