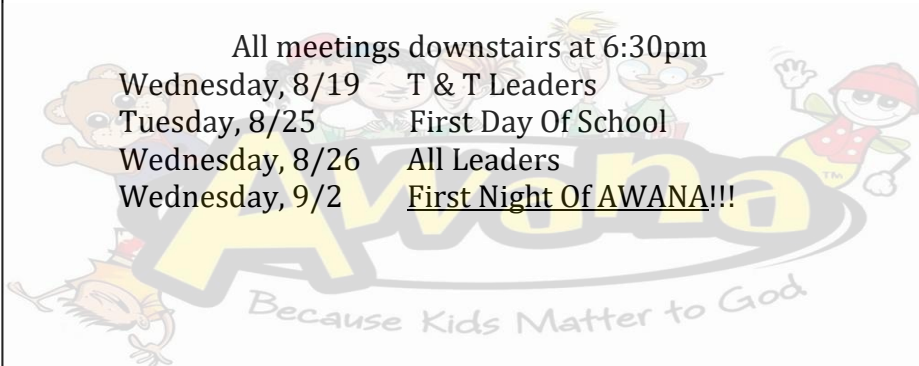

Moldova 2026



Our team from CCC is traveling this month to join up with our Global Partners in Moldova, New Hope Eurasia, Oleg & Marina Reutki. <https://www.newhopeeurasia.org/>

Our purpose is to gain a vision for how our church can connect to God's work in that part of the world. Oleg and his team have invited us to be a part of several of the outreach and service works that keep them busy throughout the year.

We will be visiting an orphanage, still a common institution in Eastern Europe as poverty and desperation drive parents to abandon children they cannot support. Also, a transition home where former orphan girls are given a safe haven before they can be swept up in human trafficking that many times originates at the exit doors of the orphanage. Here they learn God's Word, that they are loved and valuable, along with some family and home principles, and practical skills for employment.

Another outreach will be to the Roma communities who are a people with their own culture that has kept them from being included in the advances of other cultures. This isolation perpetuates distrust and hostility. Many Roma have not heard the Gospel because even the local church has its own issues with believing that this Gospel is for everyone, including the Roma.

Other outreaches include refugee families, first responders and encouraging the local church. It will be a full trip! Please pray for open hearts for those we will serve and for our team's safety and ability to yield to God's leading.
