There mercy answers the penitent sound.

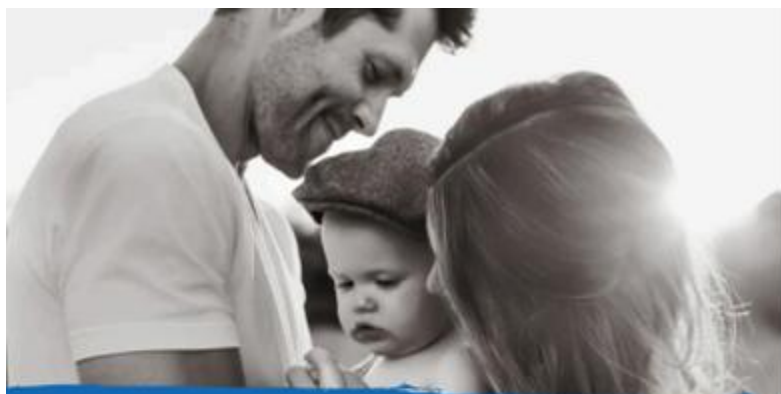
“If My people,” the quiet voice called,
