Global Partners Highlight

Oleg and Marina Reutki-New Hope Eurasia



Oleg and Marina Reutki are with New Hope Eurasia. They reside in Moldova and have a passion to reach their country and others in the Black Sea region with the love of Jesus. Since the fall of the USSR, doors have been open to share the gospel with those who lived without hope under that regime. Their focus is on the children of the next generation and they (along with their own four children) are involved in numerous ministries, including visiting orphanages; teaching in the public schools on health/social issues while sharing the gospel; partnering with local churches and training workers; conducting teen youth meetings/camps; outreach to the Roma (gypsy people) and establishing transition homes for girls who can no longer be part of the foster system once they reach age 16.

Cheney Community Church has been involved in providing financial support to them since 2018. In February 2022, Moldova saw a major influx of refugees who crossed the border from Ukraine and their team is still providing relief to those who are displaced, as well as traveling to help those who remain in Ukraine. In February 2023, a major earthquake occurred in Turkey where they have ministry connections so they have been involved in relief efforts there as well. As we look forward to this summer, CCC will be sending a small team to work alongside Oleg and experience firsthand all that is happening in this dark region desperate for hope and love.
