# Global Partners Highlight


Haley Batt, SEND



Hayley and her husband Tim moved to McGrath, AK as missionaries in 2017. God called Tim home after a battle with ALS in August 2023 and Hayley remained in McGrath to continue the ministry that He has entrusted to the team there.

She serves with SEND International as an airplane pilot/mechanic and wears many hats, including: flying SEND's Piper Cherokee Six for ministry, directing and training the ambulance squad as an EMT and EMT instructor, substituting as a teacher, and directing summer camps. She continues to be involved with One Wilderness Ministries in hospitality and logistics planning for ministry outreach gatherings and camps for residents of the Alaskan towns nearby.

In summer 2025, our church was able to send two teams to help with ministry there: first, a construction crew, and second, a team to help with a kids' day camp. We will see if she has any needs for this summer.
