# Global Partners Highlight

## Adam & Heather Cheney Arrive Ministries



This will be the LAST month that we support Adam and Heather Cheney as they are transitioning from being support-raised missionaries to paid employees at the Mayo Clinic. Heather has been working there as a pharmacy tech and Adam's former experience as a fire chief will give him the opportunity to begin serving in a position as dispatcher.

God had allowed them to purchase their dream house in the middle of immigrant neighborhoods in downtown Rochester and they will remain there, continuing to be involved in outreach to Somali and Afghan refugees.

Cheney Community Church has supported them since 2017 when they were raising support to return for a second term with their six children to the Digo tribe in Kenya and were curious to visit their namesake town of Cheney.

Upon their return to Kenya, Heather nearly died giving birth to their seventh child due to a death curse which was put on them by the Digo tribe members. It was a testimony to the power of God when both mother and child returned to the village alive from the hospital.

Soon after, their team in Africa was disbanding so they looked for other locations to minister to Swahili-speaking refugees. They found that among the Somalis in Minnesota where they have been serving for the past several years.

Please continue to pray for them as they love and serve the people there in an effort to convey to them the love of Jesus.
