Global Partner Spotlight: The Cheney Family

Adam and Heather Cheney (pronounced Chaney) live in Minnesota and are serving immigrants arriving there from Africa and Afghanistan. Their time in Kenya allowed them to learn Swahili which helps them in their ministry. They have seven children. The two oldest girls are in college (and two more seniors are starting college in the Fall). Heather works a part-time job as a pharmacy tech at the Mayo Clinic where she is able to help provide the family with great insurance and meet people within the hospital setting. While maintaining a ministry through a variety of means (including English lessons and driving), Adam will also be starting his third and final year of doctoral studies through Portland Seminary.

His project is focused on helping bridge the divide between Somalis and Christians in their community.
