

Nelson Family-MAF-Lesotho



Luke and Amy met at Moody NW in Spokane where each pursued a Missions degree. They were thrilled to realize their dream in September 2023 when they arrived in Lesotho, Africa with their two children as missionaries with Mission Aviation Fellowship.

For their first two-year term, Luke served as Director of Operations as well as flying pastoral and medical missions. Amy's time was devoted to the home and children, as well as to hosting a local ladies bible study and to providing cross-cultural training for workers flying into neighboring villages.

During their 2025 furlough they spent considerable time in Cheney as we are their sending church. They enjoyed participating in church activities here before relocating to Minnesota to spend the final months with Luke's family.

Their biggest news was the arrival of TWIN boys on Christmas Eve -- Asa Jonas (Ace) and Jethro Jude (Jet) entered the world a month before their due date but were healthy and are growing just fine.

On February 17 they plan to return to Lesotho, thankful for the help of Luke's mother in traveling with them AND for two new MAF families who have arrived in their absence.

Pray for their readjustment with the additional children and new colleagues as they discover what serving the Lord in Lesotho will look like for their family.
