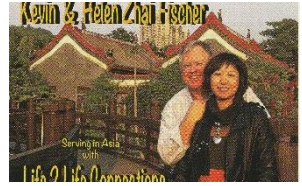
Questions for reflection and further study

Kevin and Helen have served in Southeast Asia for more than 14 years. They live in a rapidly growing city of more than 18 million people, where the median age is just 31. Their mission is to encourage, equip, and empower the next generation to live with integrity, lead with love, and make a Christ-centered impact in their communities.

They serve through a local, publicly recognized church, where Kevin holds a significant leadership role. This ministry provides a safe and legal setting in which they can teach, equip, and encourage fellow believers to live out their faith and positively influence the people around them.

Business and leadership development serve as their primary public platform. Through consulting and training with a global leadership organization, Kevin and Helen build meaningful relationships with professionals, students, and community leaders. They also help facilitate an English Corner, where authentic conversations about life and faith often develop naturally.

Recently, two participants initiated conversations about finding “peace in their soul.” These discussions created an opportunity for Kevin and Helen to share the source of their hope in an open and legally appropriate setting.
