- Haitian

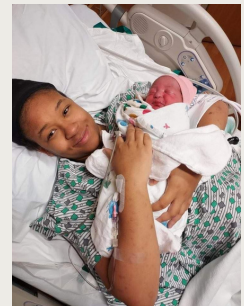
We are celebrating Strong Tower women:

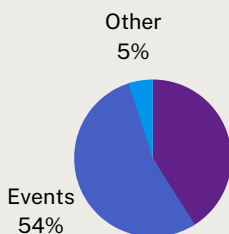

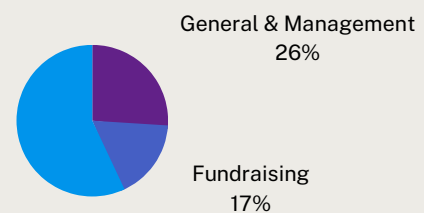
