PROJECT H.O.M.E.

The letters representing four values we know will be accomplished through our Strong Tower Program: **HOPE, OPPORTUNITY, MENTORING, EMPOWERMENT**

The Strong Tower is the comprehensive two-year program, provided in a home environment under Kingdom Pillars.



HOPE

Every Child deserves to grow up in a loving, safe family. Kingdom Pillars provides services, and support to Central Ohio women, ages 18-25, who have been

trafficked and those aging out of the foster care system; and to fostering and adoptive families committed to providing loving homes. Our Strong Tower program provides the home to restore hope and a future for these young women creating a victorious path forward.



MENTORING

Darcey McCampbell, co-founder of Kingdom Pillars, has been mentoring women for 21 years. She currently is mentoring eight women who have aged

out of foster care and/or have been sex trafficked. Darcey's mentoring role has been honed over her many years of fostering 79 children and adopting 9 with her husband Jay. The McCampbells know first-hand the trauma and brokenness caused by a childhood of instability and living in a system rather than being loved in a family. They know how to walk alongside a young adult who has been trafficked for sex. Five of the nine children they adopted were trafficked—by biological family and/or while in foster care. The national statistics vary from study to study, but sadly they range from 50% up to 80% of children in foster care having been trafficked going into or during foster care.



OPPORTUNITY

The destructive path vs the Strong Tower path. Young women will commit crimes to get caught just so they are safe from the dangers of

being on the streets. According to the Licking County Justice Center, the cost to house an inmate is \$108 per day. That is \$3240 per month. The cost of providing housing and daily living costs is estimated to be around \$28 a day or \$840 per month. For a fourth of the cost of incarceration, our Strong Tower Home will provide a safe warm place to live and sleep, food, mentoring, mental health services in a family environment, preparation and life skills needed to become an independent woman and part of society.



EMPOWERMENT

The expanded Strong Tower program will be built upon pillars that will strengthen each lady committed to her path forward. Our program

components to create her personal journey are dependable housing, safety and trust, mental health, mentoring, education and life skills, and spiritual growth.

We believe we are on the right path but need you the people to help our Strong Tower ladies to have a place to call HOME.



Tax Deductions are Extended for 2021

The universal deduction for charitable contributions has been extended to include gifts made in 2021. Without itemizing, an individual may deduct up to \$300 (\$600 for a married couple) in annual charitable contributions in 2021. Those itemizing in 2021, may deduct contributions up to 100% of their adjusted gross income. Corporations may increase giving to 25% of their taxable income.
