#### Infrastructure, Mentoring, Strong Tower

**~Co**rrected the 2018 problems. **~IR**S/State Filings. **~Cr**eated Communication tools: website, brochures, newsletters.

~Assembled Development Team. ~Defined Scope & Sequence of the full Strong Tower 2-year program. ~Established Network of Community Partners. ~Assembled mental health resources. ~Fundraising. ~Pursuing a safe location for Strong Tower women to call home. ~8 young women require direct help & resources along with mentoring.

Kingdom Pillars provides services and support to Central Ohio women, ages 18-25, who have aged out of foster care/been trafficked; and to fostering and adoptive families committed to providing loving homes.

## 2021 A LOOK AHEAD

#### **Strong Tower Home & Personnel**

To fully offer Strong Tower, we need a safe haven for women to call home. Though COVID-19 slowed our progress, we hope to have the building/land at least identified by end of 2020. We expect to begin raising funds for the building, and administrative and program staff. Currently, much of the administrative and all the mentoring work is self-funded and volunteer.




#### FROM "KC"...A MENTEE LIVING HER BEST LIFE NOW
