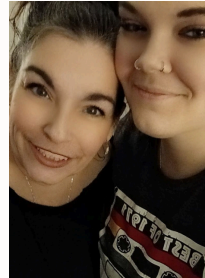
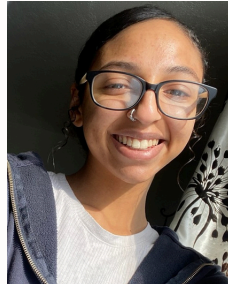
## Strong Tower (Residential)

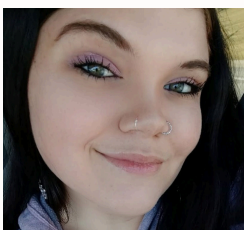

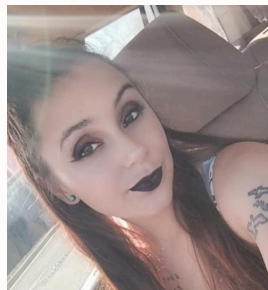

## Community Awareness & Training



As part of our efforts to stop human trafficking, we hosted a community awareness and training event with Dr. Harry Caplinger, founder of Phoenix SOG. Phoenix SOG is one of our community partners who locates missing persons and rescues human trafficking commercial sex victims.

We discussed the far-reaching consequences of human trafficking in our local communities. Our topics included Dr. Harry's *Human Trafficking Wheel*: rescue, emergency needs, medical, psychological, spiritual, vocational training and reintegration.

In addition to regular maintenance, we **added a large laundry** and **second full bathroom**, along with **major plumbing repairs**.



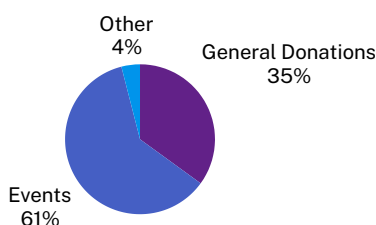

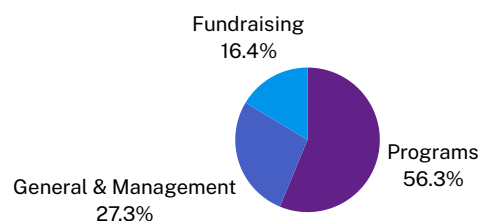
