1. ENTRY FORM

To become a competing couple, they must first fill out an entry form and return it with the entry fee by the required deadline.

2. COSTUMES

Couples will be dressed in matching costumes (i.e., both in Tahitian more' ote'a skirts or both in pareo). Stage props, backdrops, Fog machines or handheld props or adornments whether attached to the costume or not are prohibited. Head adornment and/or accessories are encouraged to be made of live flowers, shells, feathers and other naturally existing materials. **SILK, PLASTIC, FOAM FLOWERS OR FOLIAGE IS PROHIBITED. NO HOT GLUE.**
