Tournament Rules Revised 2026

1. Selection of the tournament city shall be approved by the membership from the invitations received at the Annual Meeting. Tournament dates will be selected by the Board of Directors. A minimum of 24 lanes are required to host the tournament, with management agreeing to accept additional squads when tournament entries warrant.
2. Entry fee and tournament rules will be determined by the Board of Directors. This tournament is open to all USBC female members only, and she must be a current member of the PA Women's 600 Bowling Club. Multiple entries will be allowed, but an entrant may only cash once in the Singles Event – entrants may cash more than once in the Doubles Event but with a different partner. No entry fee will be returned after October 1st and no advanced reservations will be accepted. Entries will be scheduled in order received.
3. The game played shall be the game of American tenpins and shall consist of a Doubles Event and a Singles Event. Doubles and Singles do not need to be bowled on successive squads or on the same day. Three games will be bowled on a pair of lanes. Members will be notified of date and time scheduled to bowl.
4. This USBC Certified Tournament shall be based on both scratch and handicap prize funds, using 100% of 210. All prize fees collected will be returned 100%. Checks will be mailed with 30 days.
5. Entrants must use their highest USBC certified league average from the 2025-26 winter or summer season, based on 21 games or more. A bowler not having a previous average shall use her current league average of 12 games as of October 1st, 2026, and must be verified by her league secretary. A player not having an established average shall be permitted to bowl with a scratch average of 210. USBC female youth or collegiate averages will be accepted. Sport Bowling averages will be adjusted according to USBC Rules. An entrant is responsible for verifying her own average, whether submitted by herself or others.
6. Entrants will not be required to report 10 pin increase in average nor will they be required to report any previous tournament prize winnings. USBC rules 319a-2 and 319-d are waived for this tournament.
7. Bowlers should report one-half hour before scheduled time. A player arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. In the event a player does not complete her series, she shall receive zero (0) pins for frames not completed.
8. In case of a mechanical malfunction of an automatic scoring device, the bowler will be given the option of re-rolling per USBC Rule 327c. If an automatic pinsetter has a breakdown during tournament play, tournament officials have the right to move the bowlers to other lanes as they become available. Touching or tampering with the automatic scoring devices by an unauthorized bowler shall result in immediate disqualification.
9. Errors in scoring must be presented within 24 hours. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager. Violations of rules will subject entrant to forfeiture of entry fees paid and disqualification from the prize lists. The Board of Directors shall decide any questions not covered in the Tournament Rules, and their decision shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
10. Entrants in this tournament do so at their own risk of personal injury. The PA Women's 600 Bowling Club shall not be liable for loss to personal property or personal injury received by a participant during travel to and from this competition.

PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. A \$35.00 SERVICE FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS, AND MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE PARTICIPATING IN ANY PA WOMEN'S 600 BOWLING CLUB TOURNAMENT.
