Supply List for H&H/ECA Quilting Workshop

- Sewing machine in good working order and knowledge of its use (Bring your manual)
- Extension cord and power strip (if you have one)
- Neutral 50 weight thread (cream or off-white) for piecing
- Self-healing cutting mat at least 18" x 24"
- Rotary cutter (45mm)
- Rotary cutting ruler, preferably 6 ½" x 24" (6" x 24" is okay)
- Straight pins (fine is better)
- Large (#2) safety pins (approximately 60)
- Dressmaker's tape or metal tape measure that locks in position
- ¼ inch presser foot (strongly recommended)
- 12 ½" square quilting ruler (if you already own one)
- Walking foot (if you already own one)
- General sewing tools (scissors, seam ripper)

The Hearts and Hands/ECA Quilters' Guild will provide the fabric and batting to complete a quilt approximately 44 x 56 inches.

In addition to learning how to use a rotary cutter, you will also learn:

- ✓ accuracy in piecing
- ✓ how to add borders
- ✓ how to mark your quilt top for quilting
- ✓ how to prepare the backing
- ✓ how to layer the quilt in preparation for quilting
- ✓ how to quilt your top using your machine
- ✓ how to prepare and attach a continuous binding
