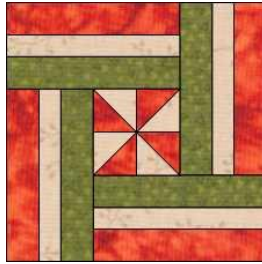


Hearts and Hands BOM August 2025

Fenced In



Fabric Requirements: Orange, Olive green and Cream

Cutting Directions:

From orange, cut 4 strips $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2''$ and 2 squares $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

From green, cut 4 strips $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2''$

From cream, cut 4 strips $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ and 2 squares $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

Assembly Directions:

Pinwheel:

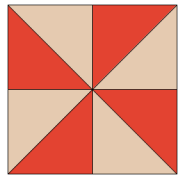
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 cream squares. Pair with the 2 orange squares and place them right sides (RST) together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the orange. Each HST should measure $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square.



Assemble the pinwheel:

Sew 2 HST together and press to the right. Make 2. Each unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$.

Sew the two units together and spin the center seam. The pinwheel should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$.



Strip Units:

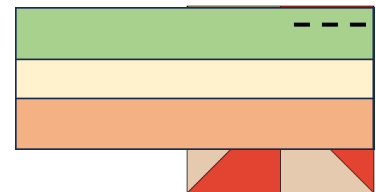
Sew the orange strip to the cream strip; press to the orange strip. Add the green strip to the unit and press to the green strip. Make 4. Each strip unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$



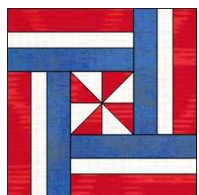
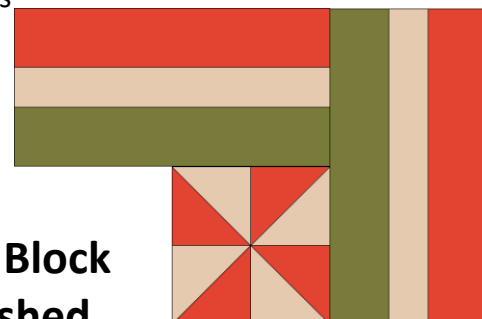
Assemble the Block:

Note: This block uses a partial seam technique.

Sew one strip unit to the top of the pinwheel RST by a sewing $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam that is about $1\frac{1}{2}''$ long to the top right corner of the pinwheel. *Note: The graphic shows an enlarged pinwheel only to show placement – the strip set and pinwheel are actually the same height.*



Finger press the strip unit away from the pinwheel. Add second strip set to the right of this unit and press away from the center. Continue adding the strip sets in a clockwise direction. When the fourth strip set is added; complete sewing the first seam. Press away from the center



RWB Option:

Substitute white for cream, red for orange and blue for green
