Hearts \& Hands Quilters Guild Block of the Month May 2023 - Bradford Nine Patch


Fabric Requirements: purple and 2 shades of green

## Cutting Instructions:

Purple: cut 4 squares $43 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Darker green: cut 8 strips $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 43 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and 4 squares $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Lighter green: cut 4 strips $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 43 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and 5 squares $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{11 /{ }^{\prime \prime}}{}$

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew a dark green strip to a light green strip press to the dark side
2. Sew a second dark green strip to the other side of the unit you made in Step 1 and press to the dark side.
3. Make the center nine patch, by sewing the squares together in rows and press to the dark. Then sew the 3 rows together and press away from the center. Your nine patch should $23 / 4$ " square.
4. Sew a purple square to each side of the strip made in Step 1. Press to the strip set. Make 2.
5. Sew a strip set to each side of the nine patch made in Step 3 nesting your seams. Press away from the nine patch.

6. Assemble the block in rows as shown at the top of the page. Press away from the center.
