

## 2026 Mystery

### Clue 3 – Square

From Background, cut 6 squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"

*Table Runner Option – Cut 1 square*

### Clue 4

#### Triangle in a Square

(Requires the Tri-Recs Ruler or Spikey & Peaky Ruler)

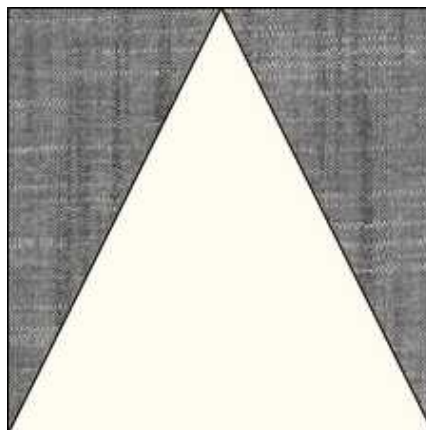
Or use the free paper pieced foundation at  
Generations Quilt/Techniques/Paper Piecing/ Triangle in a Square/ 4" Finished

Use Color 2 for the half rectangles and Background for the Triangle  
Unit should measure 4 ½" square

If using either of the rulers, cut a strip 4 ½" wide . For the half  
rectangle pieces, fold the strip right sides together to cut the pairs.  
(Note: If using the rulers, it is recommended that you make a test block to make sure  
that your unit finishes at the right size.)

You will need 48 half rectangles and 24 triangles. Sew the half  
rectangles to each side of the triangles and press away from the  
triangle.

**Make a total of 24 units.**
