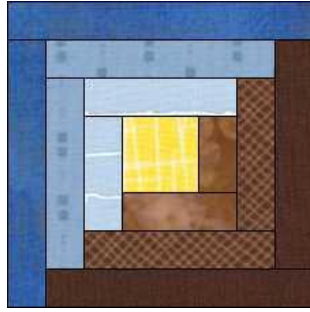


Hearts and Hands BOM

October 2025 – Log Cabin



Fabric Requirements: Yellow, 3 shades of blue, 3 shades of brown

Cutting Directions:

Cut a 3 ½" square of yellow

Cut a 2 x 3 ½" strip of light brown

Cut a 2" x 5" strip of light brown

Cut a 2" x 5" strip of light blue

Cut a 2" x 6 ½" strip of light blue

Cut a 2" x 6 ½" strip of medium brown

Cut a 2" x 8" strip of your medium brown

Cut a 2" x 8" strip of medium blue

Cut a 2" x 9 ½" strip of medium blue

Cut a 2" x 9 ½" strip of dark brown

Cut a 2" x 11" strip of dark brown

Cut a 2" x 11" strip of dark blue

Cut a 2" x 12 ½" strip of dark blue

Sewing Directions:

Sew the 3 ½" light brown strip to the right side of the 3 ½" square; press away from the square

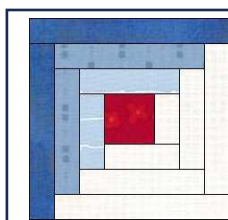
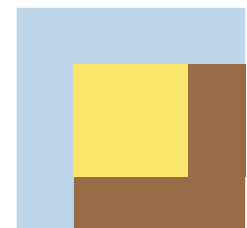
Sew the 5" light brown strip to bottom of the rectangle you just made; press to the strip you added. This should measure 5" square

Sew the 5" light blue strip to left side of the square you just made; press to the strip you added

Sew the 6 ½" light blue strip to top of the rectangle; press to the strip you added. This unit should measure 6 ½" square

Continue adding strips moving in a clockwise direction. Each strip you add will be sewn across the last seam that you sewed.

After the next 2 strips, the square should be 8". Each additions of 2 strips will form a square – the next square will be 9 ½"; the one after that 11" and the final square will be 12 ½".



RWB Option:

Substitute red for yellow and white for brown
