## Block of the Month

July 2022 - Dark-Light Star

## Fabric requirements: Red and white on white

## Cutting Directions:

From red: cut one square $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
cut one square $35 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (will be used to make corner HST)
cut one square $53 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut once on the diagonal (you need one triangle)
cut four squares $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, ; draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square cut two rectangles $5^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
From white: cut one square $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
cut one square $35 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side cut one square $53 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 53 / 8^{\prime \prime}$; cut once on the diagonal (you need one triangle)
cut four squares $23 / 4$ " $\times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$; draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square cut two rectangles 5" $\times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$

## Sewing Directions:

Sew the large white triangle to the large red triangle along the diagonal; press to the red
Place the white $35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together with red $35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square; sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press to the red. This unit should measure $31 / 4 \prime$ square.

Place a white $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together on the corner of a red rectangle; sew just to the outside of the line-the outside of the line is the side toward the corner you'll flip toward. Your stitches should barely touch the line you drew. Trim a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam; press away from the rectangle. Repeat on the other corner of the rectangle. Make two red rectangle units. Repeat with the small red squares and
 white rectangles.

Sew the block in rows


Press Rows 1 and 3 to the outside Press Row 2 to the center
Sew the rows together, press open
 Quilts for Vets option: Use blue for the large red center triangle, OR use blue
