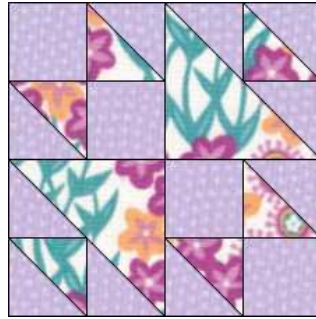


Hearts and Hands
Block of the Month
April 2024 – Fox and Geese



Fabric Requirements: Lavender and a coordinating floral print

Cutting Instructions:

From lavender: cut 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$

cut 5 squares $3\frac{7}{8}'' \times 3\frac{7}{8}''$ and sub-cut 2 of the squares once on the diagonal

From print: cut 3 squares $3\frac{7}{8}'' \times 3\frac{7}{8}''$ and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side

cut 1 square $6\frac{7}{8}'' \times 6\frac{7}{8}''$ and cut once on the diagonal

Sewing Instructions:

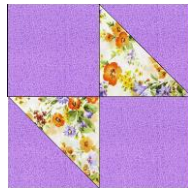
1. Place three of small print squares RST with three of the lavender squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ on each side of the diagonal line; press to the lavender. Make 6 HSTs. These squares should measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$.



2. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}''$ lavender square to one of the HSTs made in the Step 1. Make 4; press to the lavender square.



3. Sew 2 of the rectangles made in Step 2 to each other to make a four patch unit. Swirl the seams. Make 2; these units should be $6\frac{1}{2}''$ square.



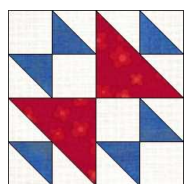
4. Sew a lavender triangle to each side of the remaining HSTs. Press to the triangles. Make 2.



5. Sew the triangle made in Step 4 to a large print triangle. Press to the print triangle. Make 2; these units should measure $6\frac{1}{2}''$ square.



6. Sew a four patch unit to the large triangle unit following the diagram at the top of the page. Press to the large triangle. Sew the rows together and swirl the seams.



RWB Option – substitute blue and red for the print fabric. Use a white background
