Block of the Month August 2019 – Log Cabin



Fabric Requirements:

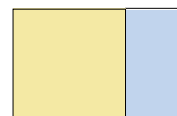
- 3" square of yellow
- 3 shades of a color of your choice
- 3 different white (including white on white) fabrics

Cutting Instructions:

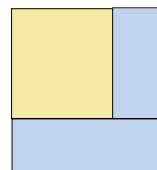
- Cut a 3" square of yellow
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 3" strip of your lightest color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 4 1/4" strip of your lightest color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" strip of your medium color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 6 3/4" strip of your medium color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 8" strip of your darkest color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 9 1/4" strip of your darkest color
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 4 1/4" strip of your first white
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" strip of your first white
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 6 3/4" strip of your second white
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 8" strip of your second white
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 9 1/4" strip of your third white
- Cut a 1 3/4" x 10 1/2" strip of your third white

Sewing Instructions:

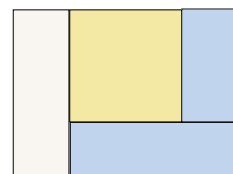
Sew the 3" colored strip to the right side of the 3" square; press away from the square



Sew the 4 1/4" colored strip to bottom of the rectangle shown above

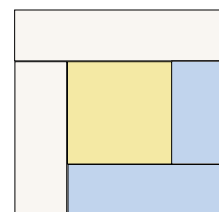


Sew the 4 1/4" white strip to left side of the square you just made



Sew the 5 1/2" white strip to top of the rectangle you just made

Continue adding strips moving in a clockwise direction. Each strip you add will be sewn across the last seam that you sewed



This is a 10" finished block
