


Hearts and Hands  
Block of the Month  
March 2020 - Scottie



**Fabric requirements:**

You will need two fabrics for this block - a white on white background fabric and a bright fabric of your choice

**Cutting Directions:**

- Cut 10 - 2 ½" squares of your background fabric
- Cut 9 – 2 ½" squares of your bright fabric
- Cut 3 – 2 7/8" squares of your background fabric
- Cut 3 - 2 7/8" squares of your bright fabric
- Cut 1 - 2 ½" by 1 ½" rectangle of your bright fabric
- Cut 1 – 1 7/8" square of your background fabric
- Cut 1 - 1 7/8" square of your bright fabric

**Sewing Directions:**

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of your 2 7/8" background squares and your 1 7/8" background square

Place these squares right sides together with the bright squares of the same size and sew ¼" on each side of line.

Cut on the diagonal line and press to the dark side of the large triangles. Press one of the small triangles to the dark and one to the light.. You will have made 6 – 2 ½" HSTs (you need 5) and 2 – 1 ½" HSTs

Sew the 2 small HSTs together to form the rectangle in row 3 of the block diagram, press this seam open and then sew this to the small bright rectangle to form the square in row 3

Lay all of your squares and HSTs out to form the silhouette of the Scottie. Sew them together in rows, pressing row 1,3, and 5 to the left and rows 2 and 4 to the right.

Sew the rows together, pressing to the bottom

**The block is 10.5" unfinished; 10" finished.**
