
Hearts and Hands Block of the Month May 2021 - Unnamed Block



Fabric requirements: White on white and a small floral print. Since there will be many seams cut and sewn on the bias, a recommendation is to starch/size your fabric before cutting.

Cutting Directions:

From WoW, cut 2 strips 2 ½" x 15" (these will be cut into picket pieces); cut 4 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½" and cut 2 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" and cut once on the diagonal

From print, cut 2 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15" (these will be cut into picket pieces); cut 4 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and cut 2 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and cut once on the diagonal

Lay the 2 print strips right or wrong sides together. Make a mark at 4 7/8" on the bottom edge of the strip as shown below. Using the 45° line on your ruler, cut as shown. Make a mark at 4 7/8" on top edge of the strip and cut as shown (this is a straight, not angle, cut). Repeat this process to make four additional pickets (4 pairs of pickets/8 total).












Repeat the process above using your white strips. Remember to lay the strips right or wrong sides together to make mirror image pairs of pickets. (4 pairs of pickets/8 total)



Sewing Directions:

This block is made by constructing triangles made from the matching pairs of pickets, the small triangles and the 2 ½" squares. The instructions will show the process for one triangle which you will repeat to make 8 triangles. All seams will be pressed open.

Sew a small triangle to the short side of a picket





Sew these 2
pieces together;
you may want to
pin match your seams

Make 3 more triangles with your white pickets and sew together in pairs. Repeat with the print pickets



Sew the resulting squares Into a four patch block



The block is 12.5" unfinished; 12" finished.
