

Cutting Instructions: For one quarter of the block, cut:

From white:
2 squares $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, cut once on the diagonal 8 squares, 1", draw a diagonal line on the wrong side

From green:
2 squares $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, cut once on the diagonal
8 squares, $1^{\prime \prime}$, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side


From yellow:
Cut four each of the shapes shown below


Note: the easiest way to cut the yellow shapes is to cut a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip, fold it RST and cut mirror image shapes
From brown: cut 4 = $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ circles

## Sewing Instructions (press all seams open):

1.Snowball the rectangular corners of all the yellow pieces and trim to make sure that they are still $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and square on the end that was snowballed. (See the numbers in the diagram above)
2. Sew the $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangle (white or green) to each of the snowballed shapes making a larger triangle
3. Sew the resulting triangles together into four squares
4. Assemble the four squares as a four patch
5. Applique a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ brown circle to the center of each flower
6. Repeat 3 more times and rotate the squares to make the block
