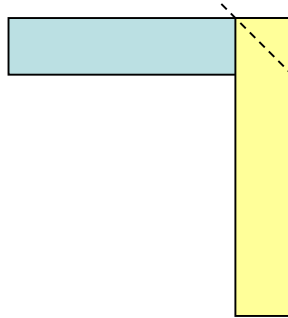


Joining Binding Ends

Start binding leaving a 6" tail. Sew binding on quilt, leaving a 6" tail. Overlap end of binding by width of binding minus $1/8$ " (e.g., 2.5" binding – overlap by $2\ 3/8$ ") and cut.

With the bulk of the quilt toward you (binding on the far side):
Open left side of binding, right side up, lay flat in a horizontal position.
Open right side of binding, right side down, lay flat in vertical position



Draw diagonal line from top left to lower right and stitch on line.

Check to see that binding fits; then trim seam, press seam open, re-fold the binding and stitch to quilt.
