

Needle Book



Using a pinking blade, cut 2 pieces of fabric 4" x 6"

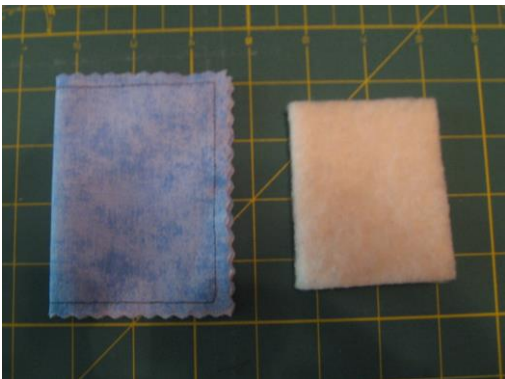
Cut 1 piece of batting 3" x 5"

If you do not have a pinking blade or pinking shears, cut the fabric 4 ½" x 6 ½"

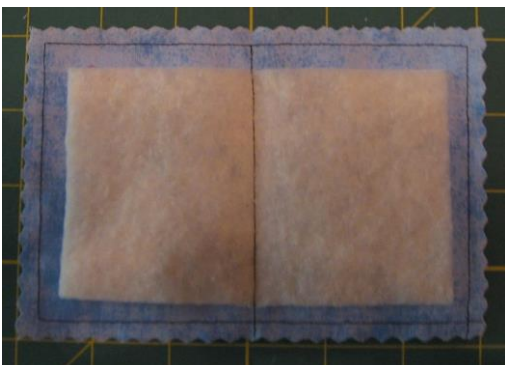


Lay the 2 pieces of fabric wrong sides together and stitch ¼" around the outside edges.

If you are working with non-pinked fabric, place the fabric right sides together, stitch ¼" around the outside edge, leaving an opening to turn the fabric right side out and press. Topstitch around the edge to close the opening.



Fold the fabric sandwich and batting in half. Crease the fabric to highlight the stitching line.



Center the batting on the fabric sandwich and stitch through the center, back tacking at each end.
