Travel Tissue Pouch

You will need two pieces of coordinating fabric. For the inside of the pouch, cut a piece 5 %" by 7%". This piece will form the lining of the pouch and the trim, so a solid or a tonal works well. For the outside of the pouch, cut a piece 5 %" by 6 %".



Place the fabrics right side together, and sew a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam down both the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides. As the lining piece is larger, the object won't lie flat at this point.



Turn the object right side out and press so that the lining forms a ¼" trim strip along each end.



Now, fold the edges towards the center so that the lining is on the outside. Press the folds and sew a ¼" seam along each short end. You may serge, zig-zag or trim these seams with pinking shears or pinking blade to prevent fraying.



Trim the corners and turn right side out. You're done – wasn't that easy?
