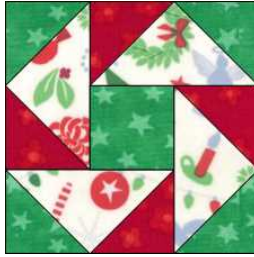


# Hearts and Hands Block of the Month November 2022 – Whirling Geese



**Fabric requirements:** Red, green and a Christmas print with light background

**Cutting Directions:**

From the Christmas print, cut 1 square  $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 8\frac{1}{4}''$ ; cut twice on the diagonal  
 From red, cut 2 squares,  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ , cut once on the diagonal  
 From green:

cut 2 squares,  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ , cut once on the diagonal  
 cut 1 square,  $3\frac{7}{8}'' \times 3\frac{7}{8}''$

**Sewing Directions:**

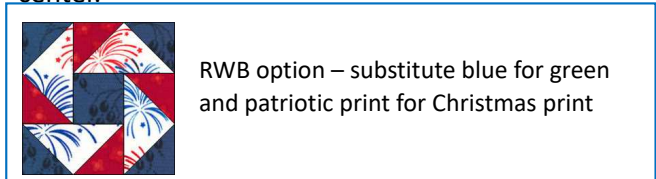
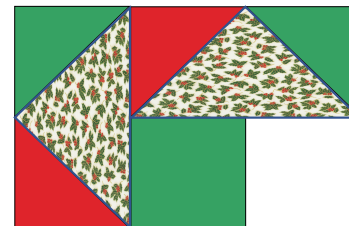
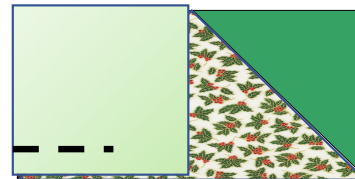
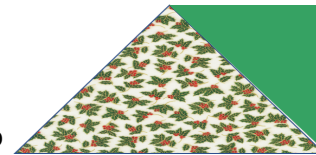
**Flying Geese:**

Sew a green triangle to the right side of the print triangle; press to the green  
 Sew a red triangle to the left side of this unit; press to the red  
 Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese

**Trim the units to  $3\frac{7}{8}'' \times 7\frac{1}{8}''$**

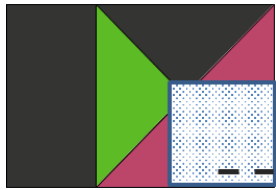
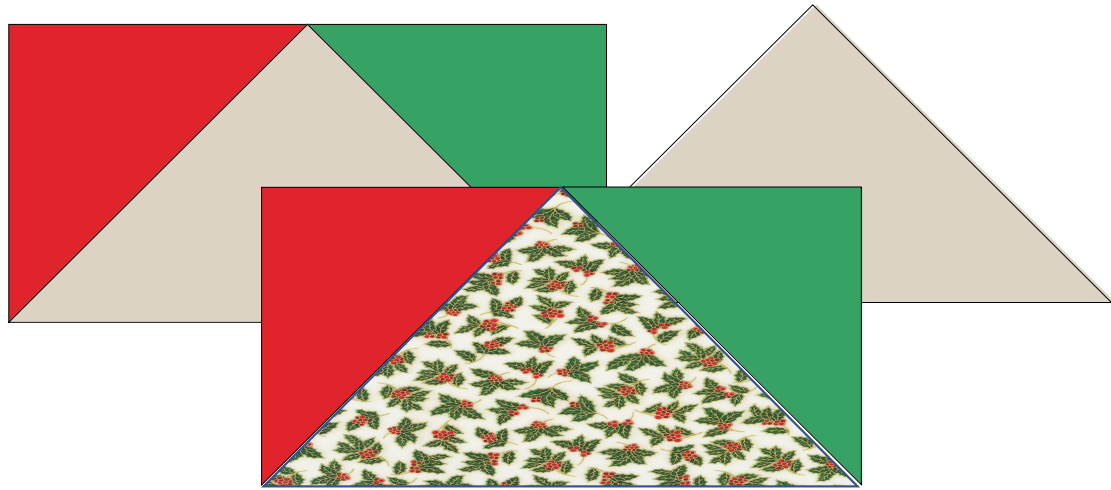
**Assembling the Block using the partial seam technique:**

Sew one Flying Geese unit to the green center square with right sides together (RST) using a partial seam shown by the dashed line; the seam should be approximately 1" in length). Finger press the partial seam away from the center.  
 Continue sewing the Flying Geese to the center adding them in a counter-clockwise direction. After sewing the last rectangle to the center, you can finish stitching the partial seam to complete the block. Press all seams away from the center.



RWB option – substitute blue for green and patriotic print for Christmas print

**The block is  $10.5''$  unfinished;  
 $10''$  finished.**
