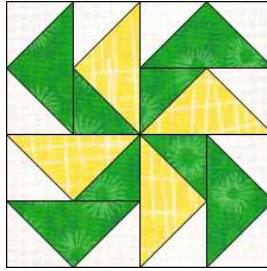


Hearts and Hands
Block of the Month
August 2022 – Yankee Puzzle



Fabric requirements: Green, a bright summery color and white on white

Cutting Directions:

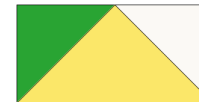
From green: cut 2 squares $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$; cut once on the diagonal
 cut one square $6\frac{1}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{4}''$; cut twice on the diagonal
 From bright: cut one square $6\frac{1}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{4}''$; cut twice on the diagonal
 From white: cut 6 squares, $3\frac{3}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$; cut once on the diagonal
 Note: the green flying geese can be made using the four at a time method; you will need 1 - $6\frac{1}{4}''$ green square and 4 - $3\frac{3}{8}''$ white squares

Sewing Directions:

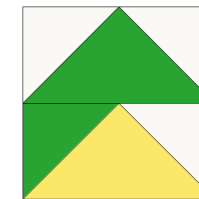
Sew a small white triangle to each side of the green triangle; press away from the green. Make four units; they should measure $3'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$



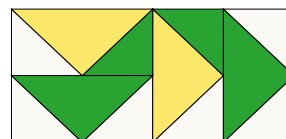
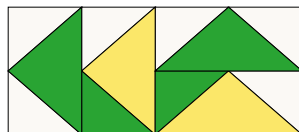
Sew a small white triangle to the right side of the bright triangle aligning the diagonal and the bottom edge. Then sew a small green triangle to left side of the bright triangle; press away from the bright. Make four units.



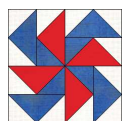
Sew a green unit to the bright unit; press toward the green triangle. This unit should be $5\frac{1}{2}''$ square. Make four units.



Assemble in two rows press the top row to the left and the bottom row to the right.



Sew the rows together; spin the center seam (If you don't know how to do this, check Quiltville.com, Tips and Techniques, Spin the 4 Patch Seams).



RWB Option –
Use blue for green and red for bright

This is a 10'' block; 10 ½'' unfinished
