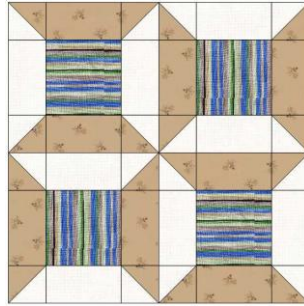

BOM November 2025 – Spoolin' Around



Fabric Requirements — White on white, tan and a stripe

Cutting Instructions:

White – cut 2 squares 5" x 5" and 8 rectangles 3 ½" x 2"

Tan - cut 2 squares 5" x 5" and 8 rectangles 3 ½" x 2"

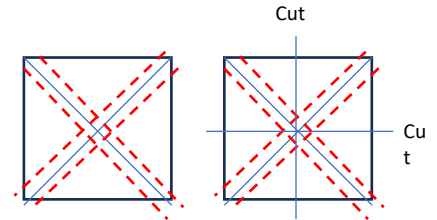
Stripe – cut 4 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½"

Sewing Instructions:

HST: (Eight at a time)

On the back of the 2 large white squares, draw two diagonal lines

Place each white square right sides together with a tan square and sew ¼" on each side of both diagonal lines. Cut the square in half horizontally and vertically. Cut on the drawn lines. Press to the tan triangle. Trim to 2". Each pair of large squares will make 8 HSTs. Make 16.



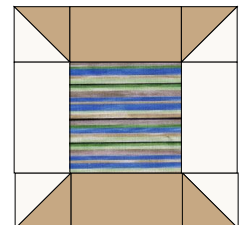
Sew an HST to each end of a tan rectangle. Press to the rectangle. This unit should measure 2" x 6 ½". Make 8.



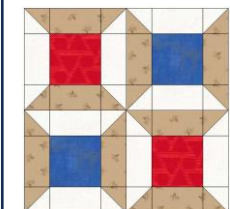
Sew a white rectangle to each side of a striped square. Press to the rectangles. This unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½". Make 4.



Sew the spool unit together in rows; press away from the center. Make 4.. This unit should measure 6 ½" square.



Sew the 4 spools together and arrange like the diagram at the top of page. Press Row 1 to the right and Row 2 to the left. Sew the rows together and spin the center.



RWB Option:

Substitute red and blue for striped squares

This is a 12" block; 12 ½" unfinished
