
Hearts and Hands BOM January 2025 Hearts-A-Whirl



Fabric Requirements:

Red, 4 Shades of Gray

Cutting Directions:

From red - cut 1 square 2 ½" x 2 ½" and 1 rectangle 2 ½" x 4 ½"

From lightest shade of gray - cut 1 square 2 ½" x 2 ½"

From all shades of gray – cut 1 square 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" & cut once on the diagonal

- cut 1 square 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" & cut once on the diagonal
- cut 1 square 7 ¼" x 7 ¼" & cut once on the diagonal



Assembly Directions:

Note: This block is constructed from the center to the outside; it is a version of a square in a square block commonly called Snail Trail.

Sew the red square to the 2 ½" light gray square; press to the red.

Sew this unit to the red rectangle; press to the rectangle; the square is 4 ½" x 4 ½".

Using two of the 3 ¼" triangles, sew one to each side the of the square made in the previous step; center on the square. Check the block at the top of the page for color placement. Press away from the square.

Add the remaining 3 ¼" triangles to the opposite sides of this unit; press away from the square. This square should measure 6 1/8".

Using the 4 7/8" triangles, sew a triangle to the top and bottom of previous unit; press away from the center.

Add the remaining 4 7/8" triangles to the sides of this unit; press away from the center. This square should measure 8 3/8".

Complete the block by adding the 6 7/8" triangles in the same manner. Press away from the center.



RWB option – substitute blue for the 4 shades of gray.
Alternate light and dark fabrics







This is a 12" finished block (12 ½" unfinished)
