

# Jar Gripper

**Supplies** – cotton fabric, shelf liner and thread

## Cutting instructions:

From shelf liner, cut one 6" square

From fabric, cut two 6" squares

## Assembly (2 Options):

### Option 1:

Place one piece of fabric right side up

Place the shelf liner on the top of the fabric

Place the second piece of wrong side up on top of the liner

Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam around the outside of the square, leaving a 4" opening for turning and clip the corners to reduce bulk

Turn the squares right side out; the shelf liner will be on the outside

Use a turning tool to push the corners until they are square

Top stitch around the outside of the gripper to close the opening; you will need to use a Teflon foot or tissue paper to stitch on the shelf liner

Stitch an "X" *through* the center of the gripper to stabilize the shelf liner

### Option 2:

Place the 2 pieces of fabric wrong sides together

Lay the shelf liner on top of the fabric sandwich

Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam around the outside of the square; you will need a Teflon foot or tissue paper to stitch on the shelf liner

Stitch an "X" through the center of the gripper to stabilize the shelf liner

Pink the edges of your sandwich using pinking shears or a wavy rotary blade
