## Chase Creek Swim Club Unaccompanied Minor Permission Form 2023 Season



This form provides your consent for your child or children between the ages of 11 and 17 to have unaccompanied access to Chase Creek Swim Club (CCSC). For safety purposes, it is important that you and your children understand and accept the requirements below. Renewed consent is required each year and will be kept on file at the pool. Thank you for your cooperation. Questions about the form or this policy may be directed to membership@chasecreekswim.org. As detailed in the CCSC Pool Rules, the privilege of being an unaccompanied minor at CCSC can be revoked for a single serious incident of not following pool rules or based on three disciplinary warnings for minor incidents. Continued discipline problems on the part of a minor can also result in forfeiture of membership and dues.

I, \_\_\_\_\_\_, parent/guardian of child(ren) listed below, who are between the ages of 11 and 17 acknowledge that my children have passed a basic water safety test administered by the pool staff and give my permission for them to be on CCSC property during normal pool opening hours without a parent, guardian or other adult supervision. I understand and agree to the following policies:

- I understand that either I or someone else listed on this form as an emergency contact must be available to get my child(ren) within 15 minutes of notification. This could be in the case of inclement weather, a child being asked to leave for not following the rules, or an emergency situation.
- I understand that CCSC does not have medical information about my child(ren). If there is a medical emergency, it is the responsibility of Ace Aquatics (the pool management and lifeguard company) to follow CPR/First Aid protocols and/or to call an ambulance if they deem necessary. If a CCSC Front Gate Attendant is on duty, this person will make every effort to locate your emergency contact information and reach you at the contact information provided below. I understand it is not the responsibility of CCSC or any of its staff to make any medical decisions.
- All unaccompanied children must comply with all CCSC policies and instructions from lifeguards while on CCSC property. A few particularly important rules for minors to be aware of include: (1) no stealing from concessions or other members' personal property, (2) do not enter the lifeguard office or concessions area, (3) no running on any of the concrete surfaces around the pool, (4) refrain from use of any foul language, (5) take responsibility for placing all of trash in the appropriate receptacles, and (5) bicycles, skateboards, and other transportation devices with wheels are not allowed inside the CCSC gates.
- Lifeguards have authority for enforcement of pool rules and to respond to emergency situations. Questions regarding a lifeguard's decision can be brought to the pool board by an adult. The <u>feedback@chasecreekswim.org</u> email goes to several board members.
- I understand it is not the responsibility of CCSC or any of its staff, to ensure my child(ren) named below remains on CCSC property, and further if my child does leave CCSC property I hold CCSC harmless.
- I further understand in the event CCSC must close due to inclement weather or any other cause, CCSC is not responsible for supervising or transporting my child(ren).
- I agree that if I am called by the CCSC manager on duty to pick my child(ren) up, I will do so as soon as possible.
