- Understand our supply chain so as to identify and assess particular product or geographical risks of modern slavery and human trafficking.
- Terminate our relationship with suppliers that fail to improve their performance in line with any action plan or violate our supplier code of conduct.
- Encourage all our employees, to report any concerns relating to unlawful conduct, malpractice, dangers to the public or the environment, and any other matter of a serious nature

We operate a comprehensive Corporate and Social Responsibility Policy to assist our approach to the identification of modern slavery risks and prevent slavery and human trafficking in our operations.
