Housekeeping

We are installing a new camera system, for the safety and security of all the campers so smile and wave if you like, we have them strategically placed around the property to ensure that trespassers are not intruding and any mischief in the park will be minimized. We must say in 15 years of camping here at Primrose Park, we have very few issues which reassures us of the quality of our campers here at the park are second to none.

Reminder to all the seasonal campers, your guests must register at the office at every single visit it is your responsibility, even when you have prepaid visitors, they must register every time. We have a new form for your guests that they personally sign with every visit. It releases us, Primrose Park, of any responsibility if your guest suffers loss or damages. I will be placing a sign in form at the front door for those guests that arrive and the office is closed. Even if it is as simple as dropping off/picking up someone/something, all need to be registered until we come up with a better system. We appreciate your help in implementing this procedure as efficiently as possible, please feel free to come to the office and we will explain it in detail.

We have mounted new fire extinguisher boxes on the outside of every hydro box in the park, located beside the pool shed, site 12, 55, 113, and site 125. They are there in case of emergency, you break the glass, pull the pin and point it at the base of the fire, if it is getting out of control, call 911 provide our emergency number 635687 Hwy 10, Mono, Ontario L9V 0Z8, and make sure someone in the office is notified to let the emergency vehicles in the gate.

Also, for your convenience we are designing improved visitor parking, to help relieve the congestion, there is visitor parking by sites 49/50 on the north west corner of the property as well as in the tenting area by the barn. These are the only 2 locations currently, we will be designing a visitor parking section in the back tenting area for extra vehicles, your sites are designed for one vehicle, sometimes 2 if you are lucky enough to have a larger lot.

Thank you all for doing such a great job of keeping your sites so neat and tidy, you have done a nice job of personalizing your space, and making it a comfortable place to be.....

Bring on summer and the warm weather, we are ready for it! The kids will be out of school and the campground will be in full swing..... thanks to all of you that make Primrose Park a family, friendly environment, we appreciate our camping family and look forward to seeing you all over the summer.
