



## **Barrel Judge**

### **Eastern Professional Chariot & Chuckwagon Association (EPCCA) Pro Tour**

The Eastern Professional Chariot & Chuckwagon Association (EPCCA) is North America's largest professional chariot and chuckwagon association, bringing high-energy racing events to communities across Saskatchewan and Western Manitoba each summer.

#### **Position Overview**

The Barrel Judging positions uphold the EPCCA's code of conduct promoting fairness, rule compliance and accuracy for all competitors during each race.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- Retrieve tablet from announcers stand prior to the beginning of each chariot/chuckwagon show (at least 15 minutes prior to start time)
- Liaise with other barrel judges and determine which barrel you are going to judge
- Set up stand (if applicable) and ensure tablet is ready for recording each race while teams are in the barrels
- Ensure the tablet is cleared of any past show recordings so enough storage on tablet for current show
- Record and observe each race to confirm the outfit stops prior to the race and completes the barrel pattern correctly
- Identify all pattern deviations (ahead of the barrels, ahead of the horn, delay of race, knocked-over barrels, missed barrels, lanes) etc. and signal penalties as required.
- Communicate penalties, no time, or disqualifications to the announcing stand crew immediately.
- Maintain fair and consistent rule enforcement for all competitors.
- Remain attentive to the entire run, from the start through the completion (you may stop recording on the tablet once all outfits have left the barreling area)
- Assist with addressing rule clarifications if questions arise
- Perform other duties as assigned by show directors, club president or any executive team member

#### **Qualifications**


- Organized, reliable, and able to work independently at events
- Must be a positive team player with a strong work ethic
- Basic computer knowledge to start/stop recording of each heat
- Past racing experience would be considered an asset

#### **Requirements**

- Reliable vehicle and ability to travel to Pro Tour events
- Ability to work during the races
- Must wear western attire during races
- Abide by EPCCA code of conduct at all times
