



## ***Infield Coordinator***

**Seasonal Position (May – September 2026)**

***Eastern Professional Chariot & Chuckwagon Association (EPCCA) Pro Tour***

The *Eastern Professional Chariot & Chuckwagon Association (EPCCA)* is North America's largest professional chariot and chuckwagon racing association, bringing exciting racing action to communities across Saskatchewan and Western Manitoba each summer.

EPCCA is looking for two dependable and organized Infield Coordinators to join our team for the 2026 EPCCA Pro Tour season.

*Two positions are being filled to help ensure all Pro Tour events are properly supported, including weekends where dual events may take place.*

These positions report to the EPCCA President and/or EPCCA Show Director and work closely with race officials, judges, competitors, and local organizing committees to help deliver safe, professional, and well-run race events.

### **Position Overview**

The Infield Coordinator helps prepare and manage the infield area during race events, ensuring equipment, track markings, and race operations are set up properly and maintained throughout the show. This role is an important part of keeping races running smoothly while maintaining a safe environment for competitors, horses, and officials.

This position is well suited to someone who enjoys working outdoors, being part of live events, and contributing to a positive team environment.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Set-up all infield equipment (barrels with covers, chalker, flags, banners, tarps, etc.) in the infield at least one (1) hour prior to show start time and return equipment following the completion of events.
- Ensure all infield equipment is clean, well-maintained, and professionally presented at all times.
- Hang EPCCA banners and signage in designated locations as instructed.
- Manage flour inventory for all shows and coordinate delivery to each event location.
- Mark and maintain all infield lines, including racing lanes and finish lines.
- Ensure chalk and flour lines remain clearly visible throughout the duration of events.
- Confirm correct barrel placement prior to each heat, ensuring sponsor and partner logos face the grandstand for maximum visibility.
- Move and adjust barrels as required to maintain safety for horses, drivers, and outriders.
- Maintain and oversee screening tarp operations, ensuring the tarp is properly positioned and readily available for immediate use when required.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized infield environment at all times.

### **Race Operations Support**

- Work closely with EPCCA judges and race officials to support safe and efficient race operations.
- Assist with pre-race safety checks of the infield area and equipment.
- Maintain communication with race officials and announcers regarding heat readiness.
- Ensure horseback judges (if applicable) begin the grand entry parade with flags and return safely to the infield following the parade.
- Support efficient staging and race flow to help keep the event running on schedule.
- Assist with set-up and tear-down of infield equipment at each event location.
- Other duties as required.

### **Qualifications**

- Strong organizational and communication skills
- Ability to remain calm and organized in a fast-paced event environment
- Comfortable working outdoors in varying weather conditions
- Ability to work well with competitors, volunteers, and event committees
- Chariot and chuckwagon racing knowledge is considered an asset
- Must be a positive and friendly team player with a strong work ethic

### **Requirements**

- Must wear western attire consisting of long sleeve western shirt, jeans and cowboy boots
  - Reliable vehicle and/or ability to travel to EPCCA Pro Tour events
- Ability to work evenings and weekends during the racing season
- Ability to stand and move around the infield for extended periods
