The Eastern Professional Chariot & Chuckwagon Association (EPCCA) is currently seeking qualified and dedicated Outriders for the 2026 EPCCA Pro Tour Season.

This role is critical to the safety, professionalism, and integrity of EPCCA race events and requires individuals with strong horsemanship, sound judgment, and the ability to perform under pressure.

POSITION OVERVIEW

Outriders play a vital role in the safe operation of EPCCA chariot and chuckwagon races. The successful candidate will be responsible for assisting in race safety, responding to incidents on track, and supporting fair competition in accordance with EPCCA rules and regulations.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide mounted safety support during all chariot and chuckwagon races
- Be capable of safely catching and controlling runaway chariots or chuckwagons
- Lead the Grand Entry / Parade of Chariots and Chuckwagons while carrying the official flag
- Monitor races for rule compliance and safety concerns
- Assess on-track incidents and apply penalties in accordance with the EPCCA Rule Book
- Work collaboratively with the EPCCA Board when reviewing protests or penalty appeals
- Maintain professionalism and uphold EPCCA standards at all times
- Represent EPCCA positively with competitors, officials, sponsors, and the public
- Follow and adhere to the EPCCA Code of Conduct

REQUIREMENTS

- Must own or have access to a horse capable of safely handling outrider duties
- Strong horsemanship and livestock-handling experience
- Knowledge of chariot and chuckwagon racing is considered an asset
- Ability to remain calm and make sound decisions in high-pressure situations
- Physically capable of performing all required duties
- Available to travel and work weekends throughout the EPCCA Pro Tour season
- Professional attitude and strong communication skills

TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

- EPCCA welcomes qualified individuals who may not yet have direct outrider experience but are eager to learn.
- Training and mentorship opportunities may be available for the right candidates who demonstrate strong horsemanship, reliability, and commitment to safety.
