IMPORTANCE OF CONSISTENCY

When home and therapy use the same words, routines, and reinforcement, your child learns faster and with less confusion.

Consistency helps them realize that the same expectations apply everywhere—not just during school and therapy sessions.

Try this: Ask your child's supervisor which strategies they're using (like token boards or specific praise) and use the same ones at home for smoother learning and fewer behavior struggles.

Schedule a parent meeting to learn how to boost your child's progress in both school and home routines.

IMPORTANT REMINDER

Therapists guide and teach, but **your** love and daily support are what help those lessons take root.

Every time you use the same strategies at home, you help your child's progress blossom.
