While many children enjoy the Halloween traditions of trick-or-treating and pumpkin carving, individuals with sensory processing disorders may interpret and react differently to these holiday activities. We offer the following tips to make this holiday a positive experience:

- Prepare for the day. To help children understand what Halloween is-and is not-read stories that reflect your values ahead of time. Try to prepare your child for some of the unexpected changes in routine like new places, treats, and costumes.
- Make costumes safe, imaginative, and comfortable. Share costume guidelines with your child ahead of time to prevent in-store meltdowns, and have your child test out his/her costume ahead of time to get used to wearing it.
- 3. Practice the sequence/routine of trick-or-treating.
- Know when to stop the activities. Look for signs of sensory overload in your child and respect their

goals! request to be "all done," when given.
